

Drinks and Fruit

Nursery snack time is a wonderful way for young children to learn more about healthy eating and social skills. Each session has a special time when the children sit together and share a selection of fresh fruit and a drink. We know that fruit helps children keep healthy and we recognise our role in promoting a healthy diet.

In Reception there is a fruit bowl, for your donations. If every child were to bring in two or three pieces of fruit a week then we would have some each day to share. We also welcome donations of £1 each week (into the pot on the reception desk) to go towards the cost of snack time (any money left over will go towards our regular "special" events!) Fruit is also welcomed in the toddler groups run by the Children's Centre.

Birthdays

Nearly all our children will celebrate a birthday during their time with us. We know how important these times are for young children and we want to make them feel as special as we can on their special day! We have birthday traditions established at Bushy Leaze and if you would like to add to these by sending in some special fruit or snack to share please do so.

Clothes and Shoes

Just a reminder for nursery families – please send your child with a spare set of clothes in case of accidents. Also, sensible footwear is essential for outdoor areas, especially to get the best use of our adventure trail. Children play outside all year round, as the weather becomes cooler please make sure your child has a coat with them every day, and wellies if necessary!

Absence

If your child is unwell or unable to attend Nursery for any reason, please ring the office as soon as possible, choosing option 2. If you are going on holiday, please let Louisa, Heather or Tammy know the dates in advance. Please note, if your child has been sick or has suffered with diarrhoea, please keep him/her at home for 48 hours after the last episode.

Policies

Please note that Hampshire County Council has a **NO SMOKING** policy on school premises and this includes the car park. Unfortunately we are also unable to allow dogs on the premises.



To try and keep everyone at Bushy Leaze as safe as possible, please can you take care in the car park and remember the following:

- No dogs in the car park
- No smoking in the car park (even in your car!)
- Always supervise your children and keep to footpaths as much as possible
- Don't let your children climb on fences or in trees
- Don't let your children eat the plants
- Keep the accessible spaces free for those with blue badges
- If possible reverse into spaces along the fence line, but go forward into accessible bays
- Do not park on yellow lines or on the hatching. If there are no spaces, please

- park in Eastbrooke Road, Nursery Road or Chautsingers.
- Keep the main gates closed
- Use the right car seat/booster in your car

Please help make Bushy Leaze a "**nut free**" zone. We have children who attend the Centre who have a serious, life threatening allergy to nuts. Please ensure that biscuits, sandwiches etc. do not contain nuts. We want all families to feel that the Centre is inclusive and that their child will be safe and secure with us.

We are also aware that at this time of year tree nuts are to be found in the local area around Bushy Leaze. We would appreciate your support in children not bringing hazelnuts, etc. into the Nursery. Thank you

Bowen Therapy is a drug-free, non-invasive, hands-on remedial therapy, which helps

the body's systems rebalance and promotes healing. It is a very gentle treatment, which most people find relaxing and de-stressing. It can also be helpful for many conditions in the body. Starting School in September 2016

Will your child be 4 years old between the 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016?

From 1st November 2015 you can apply:

- online at www.hants.gov.uk/admissions where you will also find information about schools in Hampshire; OR
- using a paper application form available from a Hampshire infant or primary school.

Schools make individual arrangements for open events in the autumn term. You are encouraged to make use of these opportunities to gather information before making an application.

Application deadline is Friday 15th January 2016

Please be aware that every year some children lose out on a place at their local school because their parents miss the application deadline.

Please visit any Hampshire infant or primary school or a Children's Centre for help with the application process, or by calling 0845 603 5623. Alternative formats can also be obtained by calling from this phone number.

Calls to 0845 numbers will cost between 4p (local rate) and 6p (national rate) per minute for BT customers. Calls made using other service providers or mobiles may cost more. Alternatively call 01329 225375 - standard and local rates may apply to this number.
