Charging Policy

Purposes

To explain to parents of the Nursery when charges are made

- Nursery places are free of charge
- Parents are asked to make a voluntary contribution of £1.00 per week towards the cost of consumables, such as cooking ingredients, additional fruit, party food. All donations are a contribution towards the cost and the nursery does not make any profit
- Children are able to attend Lunch Club – a cost of £2.50 is charged per child, per session. This money contributes directly towards staffing costs for the session
- There is a charge for activities accessed via the Centre:-
 - ❖ £2.00 per family for 'Stay & Play' session
 - ❖ £3.00 per family for 'Dad's Matter'
 - ❖ Bumps and Bundles £2.00 per session
 - ❖ First Time Parents £2.00 per session
 - ❖ Baby and Toddler groups £2.00 per session
 - ❖ Holiday Play Scheme – half day session £8.00; full day session £15.00. In some circumstances families may qualify for a discount using 'Reach Out and Have a Go' vouchers
 - ❖ £3.00 per family for 'Little Squirrels'
- Other activities may be available to families. These will be advertised accordingly with notification of the amount chargeable.

Parents who find it difficult to meet any of the charges should discuss the matter with a member of staff.
